This Privacy Policy explains how Privax.xyz, operated under the governance of DAO Privax ("Privax," "we," "us," or "our"), collects, processes, and safeguards your personal data. It also outlines your privacy rights and how you can exercise them.

1. Scope & Policy Updates

This Privacy Policy applies to data collected via our platform, Privax.xyz, and any related services we provide. It does not cover personal data managed by third-party applications or services that interact with Privax.

We may revise this Privacy Policy periodically. Updates will be communicated as required by law, and continued use of our services after revisions indicate acceptance of the changes.

2. Data We Collect

We collect information in the following ways:

A. Information You Provide

- Contact details when you reach out for support, subscribe to updates, or participate in community discussions.
- Information submitted during surveys or engagement in DAO governance activities.
- Data shared during events, business collaborations, or job applications.

B. Data Collected Automatically

- Technical details like IP address, device information, browser type, and user preferences.
- Usage metrics, such as page visits, interactions with content, and transaction logs.
- Tracking technologies like cookies and pixel tags for service optimization and security.

C. Third-Party Data Sources

We may receive information from integrated third-party services, analytics tools, or external platforms linked to Privax.xyz.

3. How We Use Your Data

We use your information to:

- Facilitate and secure interactions on Privax.xyz.
- Enable DAO governance mechanisms, including voting and proposal discussions.
- Improve the user experience through analytics and platform optimizations.
- Communicate policy updates, service enhancements, and marketing where applicable.
- Ensure compliance with legal obligations and prevent unauthorized activities.

4. Data Sharing Practices

We share data only when necessary:

- **With Service Providers:** To support technical operations, customer support, or analytics.
- **Within the DAO Ecosystem:** To uphold transparent governance and decision-making processes.
- **For Compliance & Security:** To meet legal requirements or respond to lawful requests.
- **In Business Changes:** If Privax undergoes a restructuring, merger, or acquisition, data may be transferred as part of the process.

5. Your Privacy Rights & Choices

You may have rights under applicable privacy laws, including:

- **Access & Portability:** Requesting a copy of your data.
- **Correction & Deletion:** Updating inaccurate data or requesting its removal.
- **Opt-Out Options:** Managing communication preferences and limiting tracking technologies.
- **Withdrawal of Consent:** Stopping specific data processing where consent was initially given.
